

THE CHALLENGE

Guilford County Schools currently has more than \$2 billion in facility needs. An independent study funded jointly by the commissioners and school board in 2019 found that district schools were, in some cases, literally falling apart.



The study rated more than 50% of our schools as being in poor or unsatisfactory condition with outdated systems for heating and cooling, electrical and wiring, plumbing, technology and other critical infrastructure needs.


WANTED: Members for DKG International Committees Apply for an International Appointment
