THE CHALLENGE

Guilford County Schools currently has more than **\$2 billion in facility needs**. An independent study funded jointly by the commissioners and school board in 2019 found that district schools were, in some cases, **literally falling apart**.



The study rated **more than 50% of our schools as being in poor or unsatisfactory condition** with outdated systems for heating and cooling, electrical and wiring, plumbing, technology and other critical infrastructure needs.

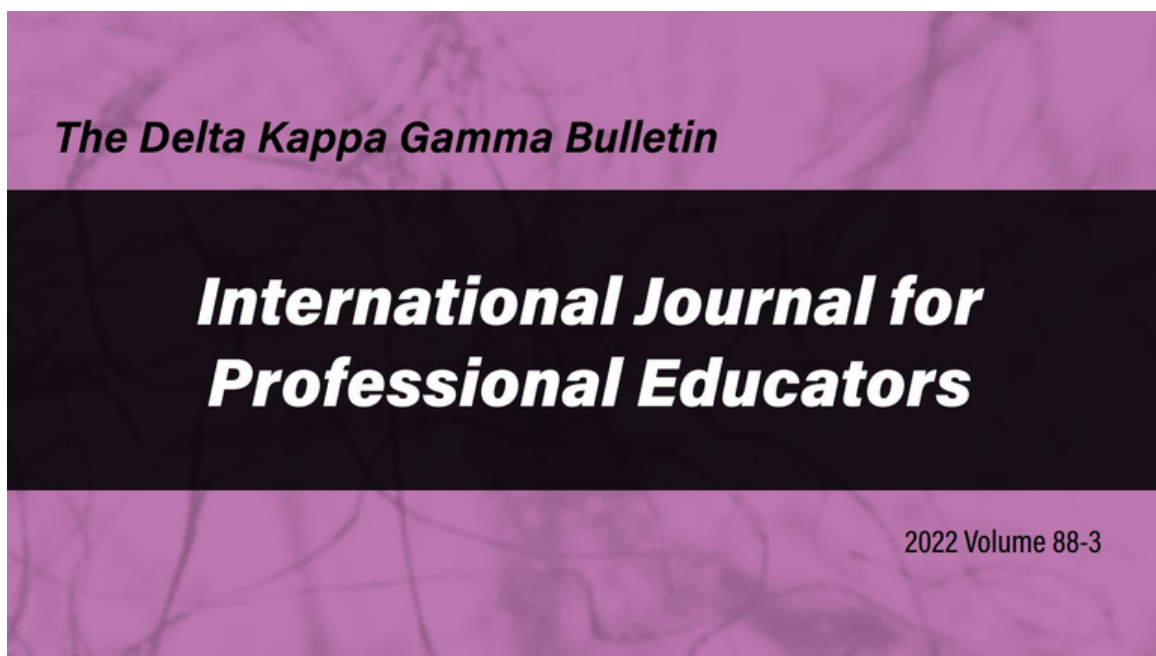
Apply for an International Appointment
